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


- 16 Families referred, 12 Families matched Families referred may opt out of participating or may still be in the process of trying to reach them to enroll them within GBYS.
- Ethnicity of the families referred:
 - o 42% Caucasian (5 families)
 - $\,\circ\,$ 16.5% Multiracial (2 families)
 - o 25% Latino (3 families)
 - o 16.5% African American (2 families)
- > Age of children enrolled in GBYS:
 - o 50% Birth-1 year old
 - \circ 17% 1-2 years old
 - o 8% 2-3 years old
 - \odot 17% 3-6 years old
 - 8% 6 years and older
- > Primary Language in the home:
 - \circ English 8 families
 - \circ Spanish 2 families
 - \odot English/ASL 2 families
- Newborn Hearing Screening results as reported by the parent:
 - o Did Not Pass 6 children
 - Passed 1 child
 - Pass/DNP 4 children
 - Unsure 1 child
- **Gender** of children enrolled in GBYS:
 - \circ 8 male, 4 female
- Medical History suggestive of:
 - Condition assoc. with a hearing loss, 5 children
 No known syndrome or etiology 6 children
 - Hereditary 1 child
- > Unilateral vs. Bilateral hearing loss:
 - \circ Bilateral 9 children
 - Unilateral 3 children
- > Insurance information of enrolled families:
 - \circ Private 8 families
 - All kids 3 families
 - \odot Did not answer 1 family
